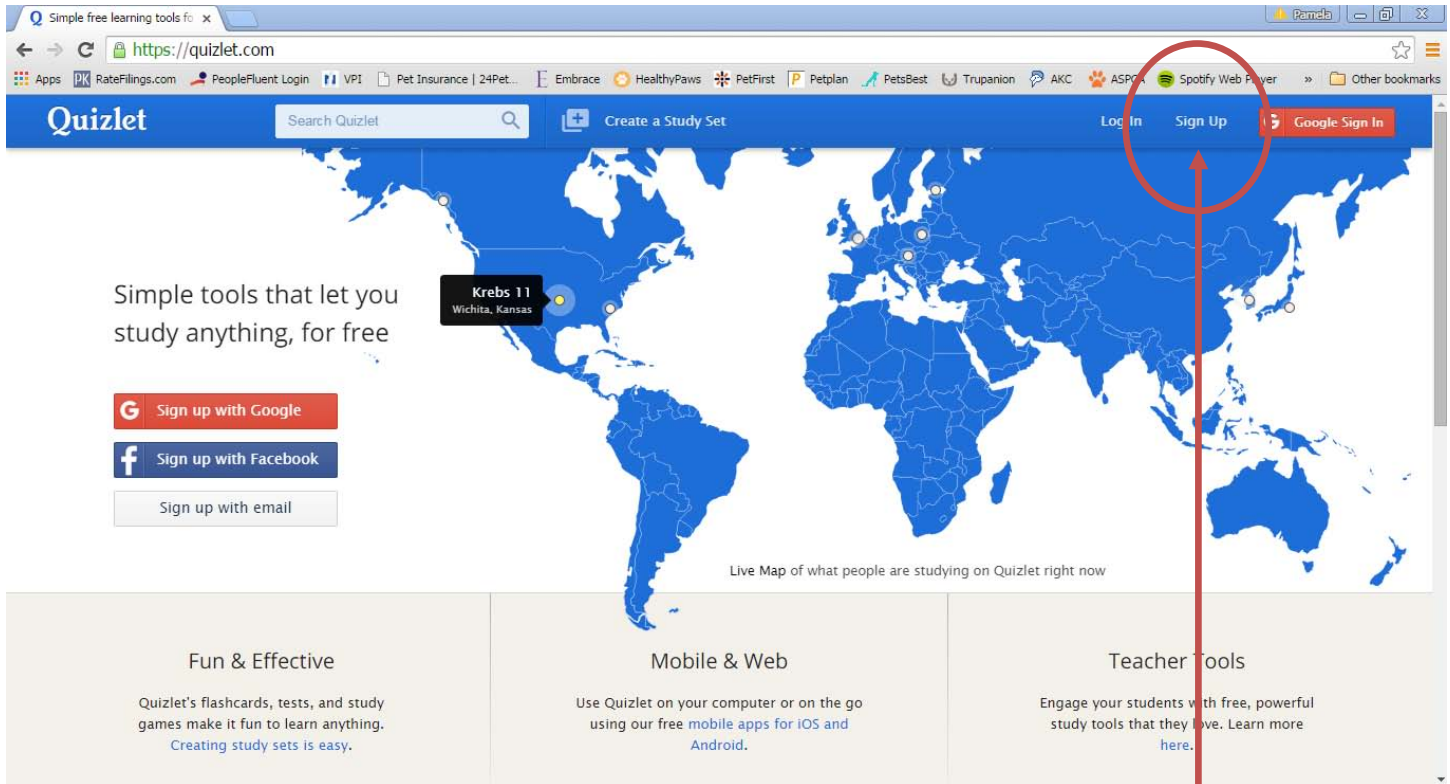




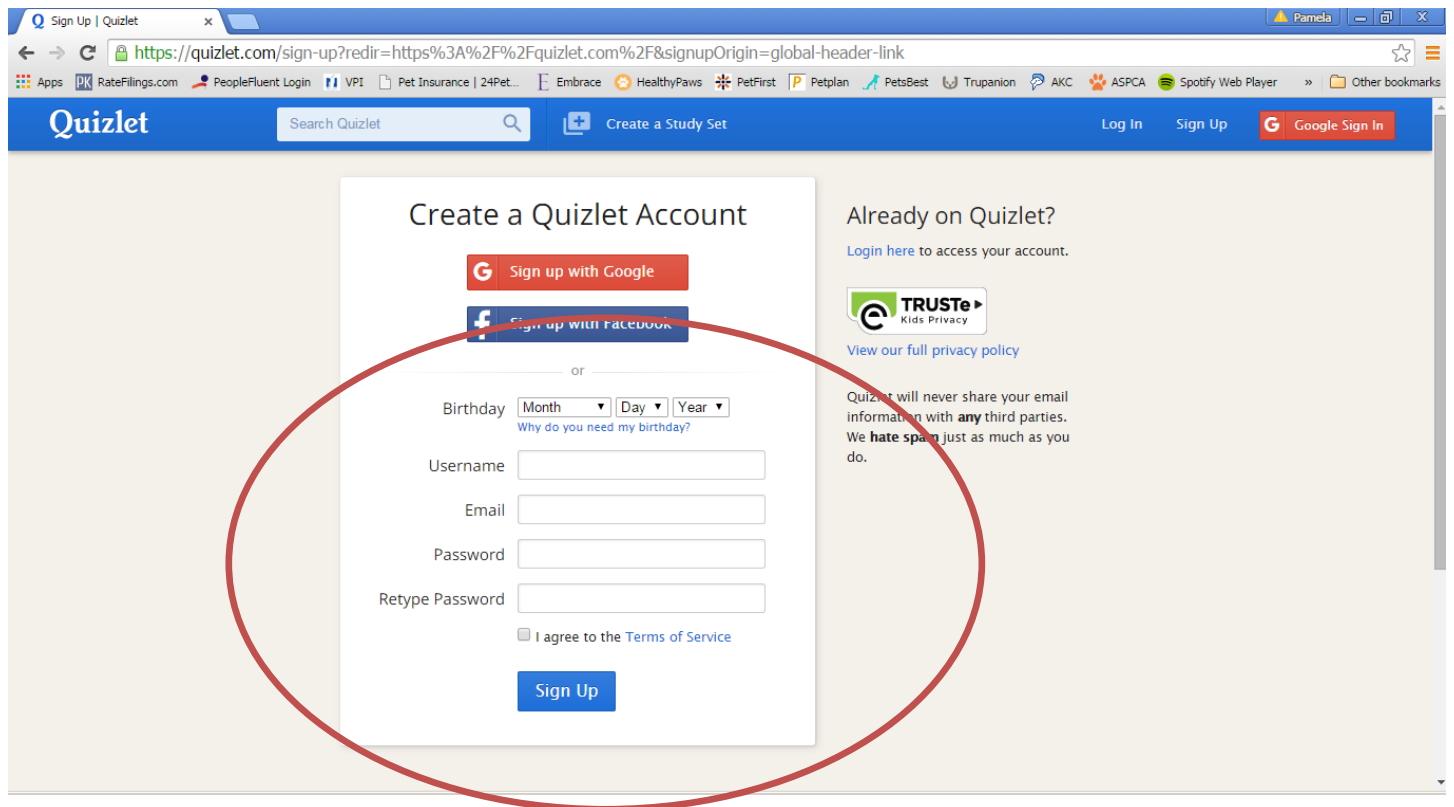
How to use Quizlet



Go to www.Quizlet.com to get started.

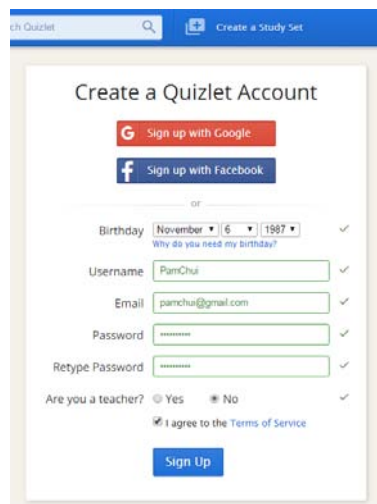


Click "Sign up" to get started



Fill out the information in the box.

For example:

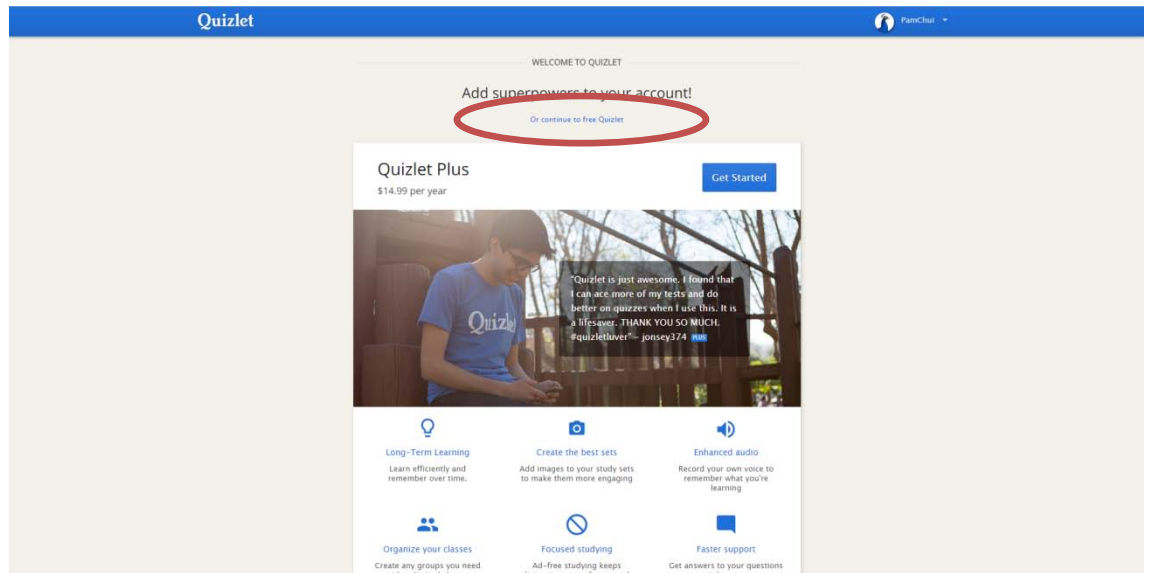


Make sure the boxes have green check marks next to them. If they do not, it means you did not put the information in correctly.

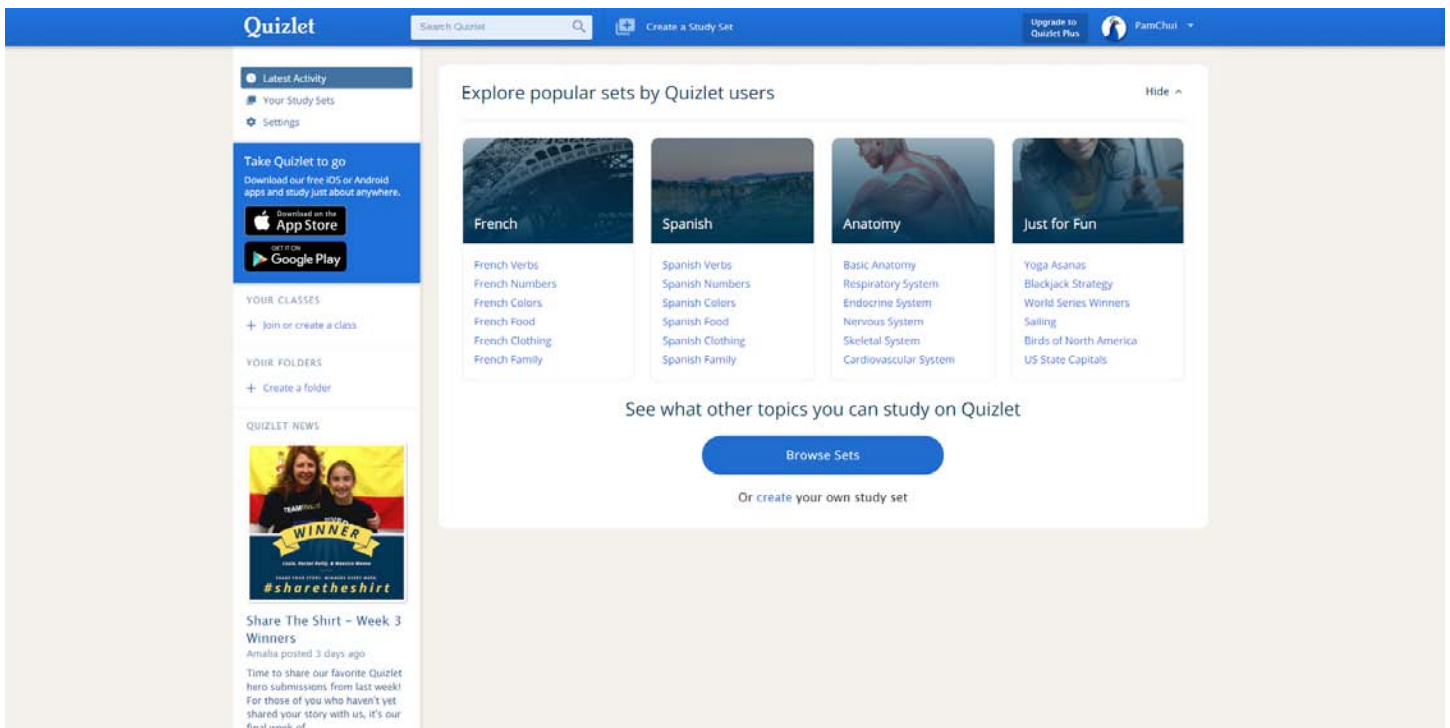
If the “username” box does not have a green check mark, it means you need to choose a different “username”.

After you complete the information, click “sign up”.

after you sign up.

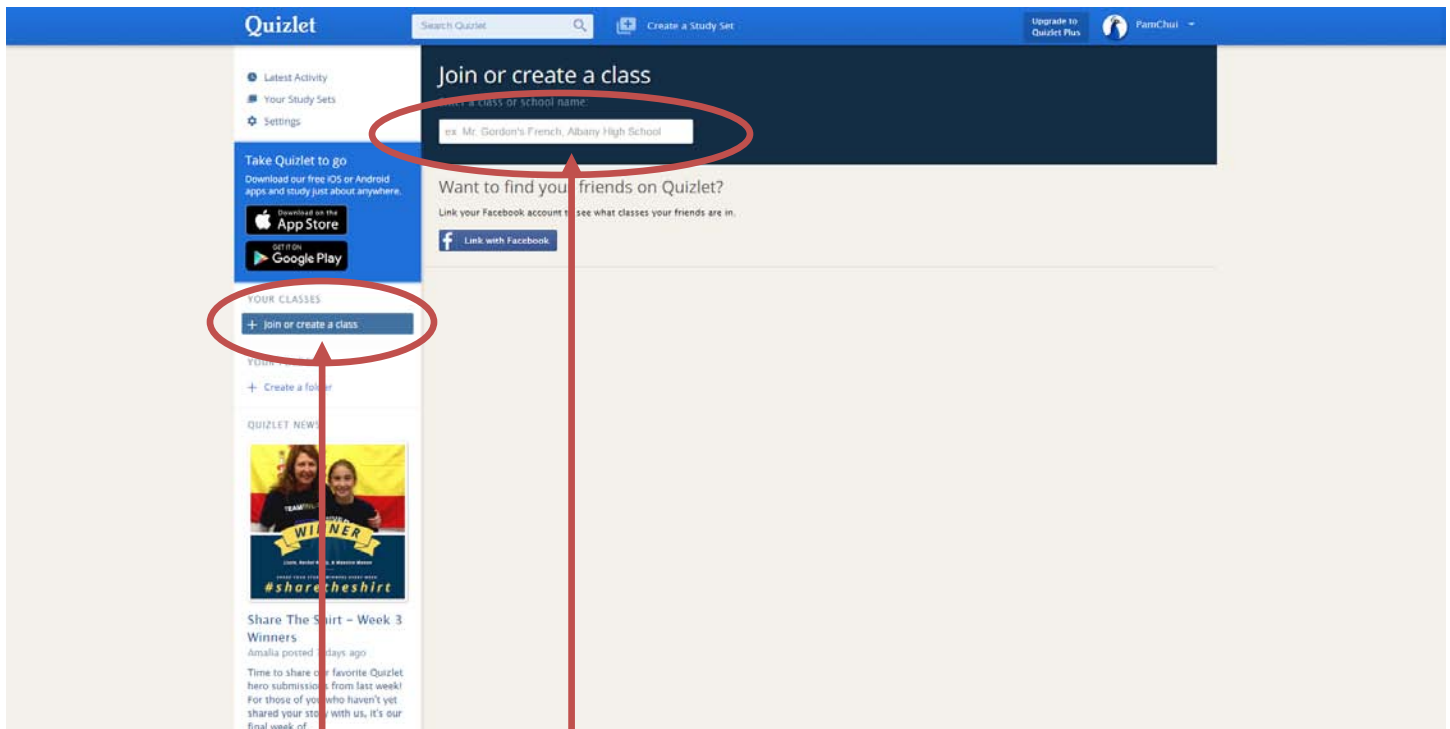


This is what you will see after you are signed up for a free account.



How To Join A Class

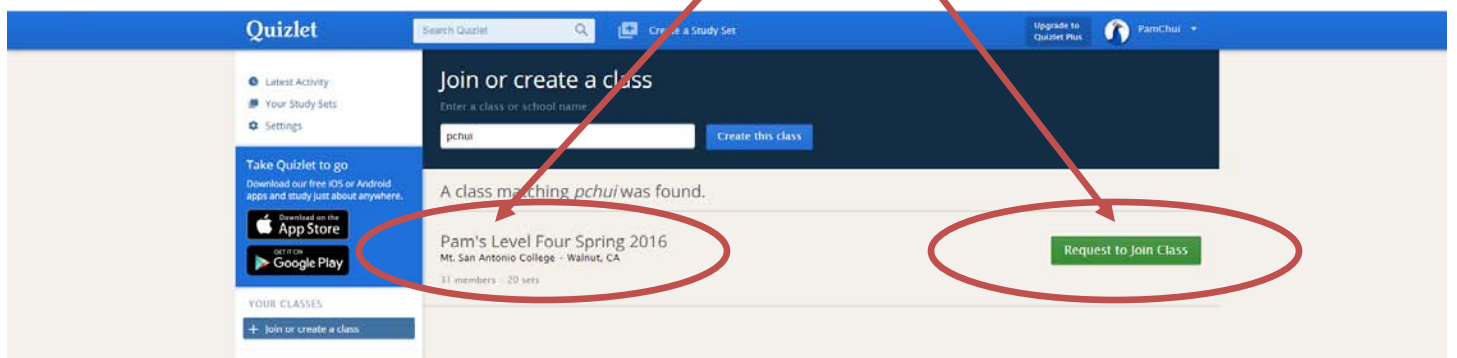
After you have a free account, join your class so that you can share vocabulary cards with your classmates.

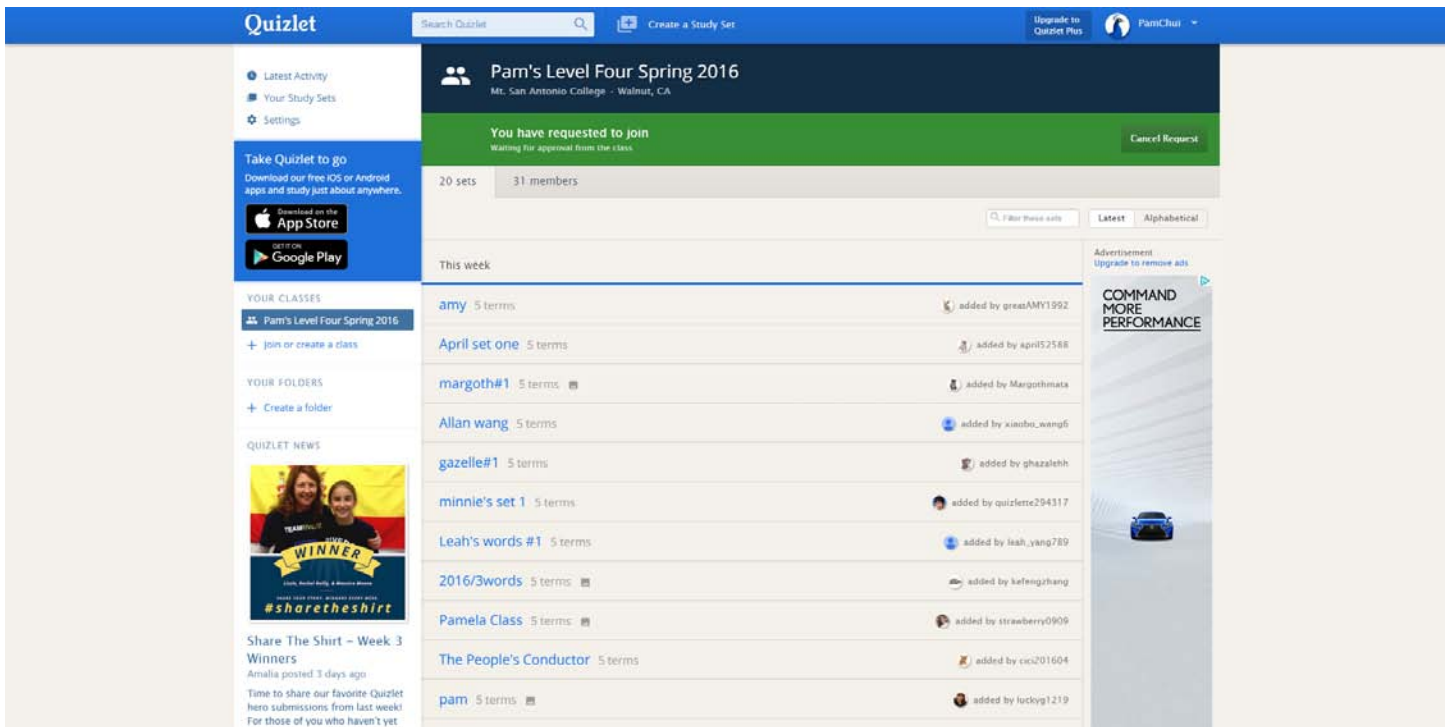


First, click on the "Join or create a class" link on the left side of the screen.

Second, ask your teacher for his or her class name or username to search for his or her class.

Third, find his or her class and click "Request to join class".

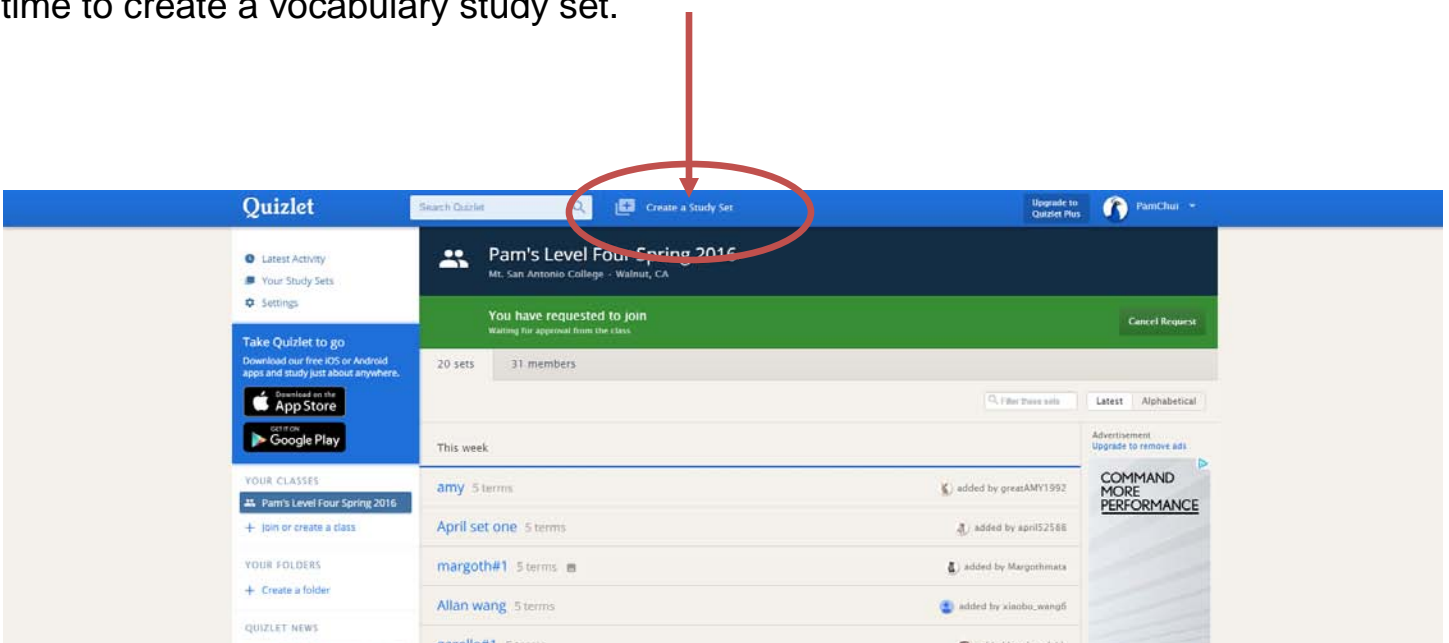




After you join a class, you'll be able to see the other members and their vocabulary sets. You can share vocabulary sets with the class and use other member's vocabulary sets to study as well.

How To Create A Vocabulary Set

At the very top of the page, you will see a "Create a Study Set" link. Click on this at any time to create a vocabulary study set.

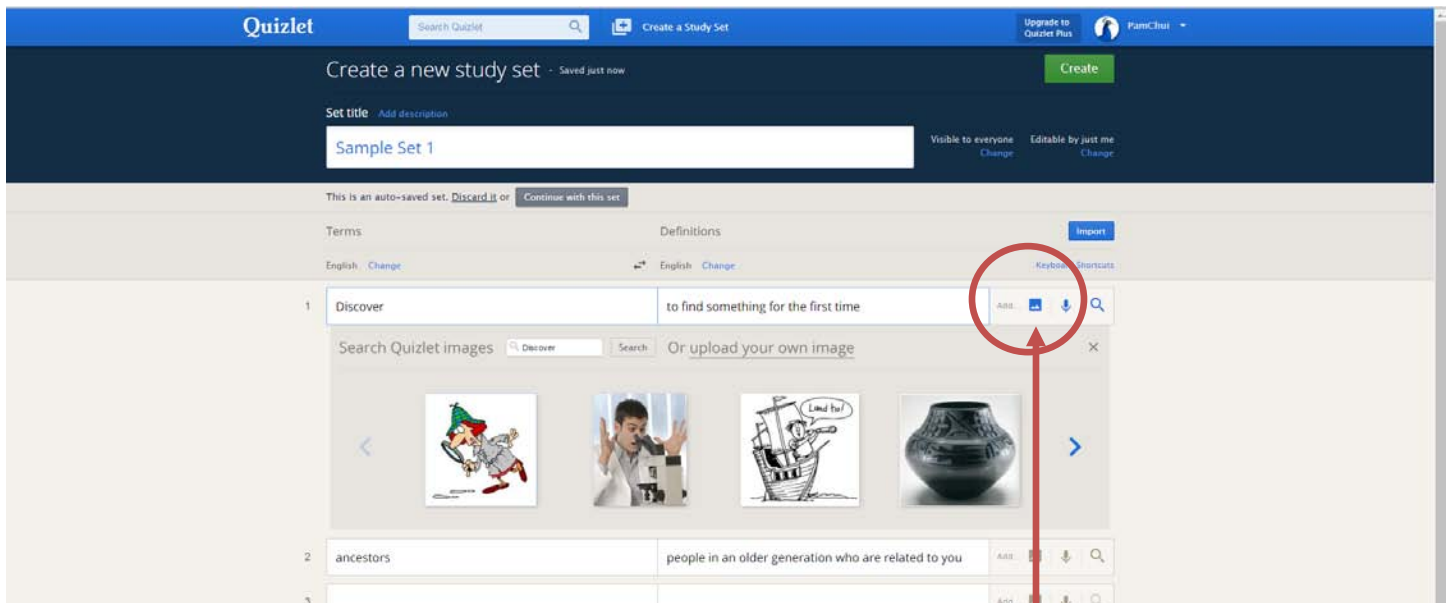


You will need to give your set a title and set the language to English.

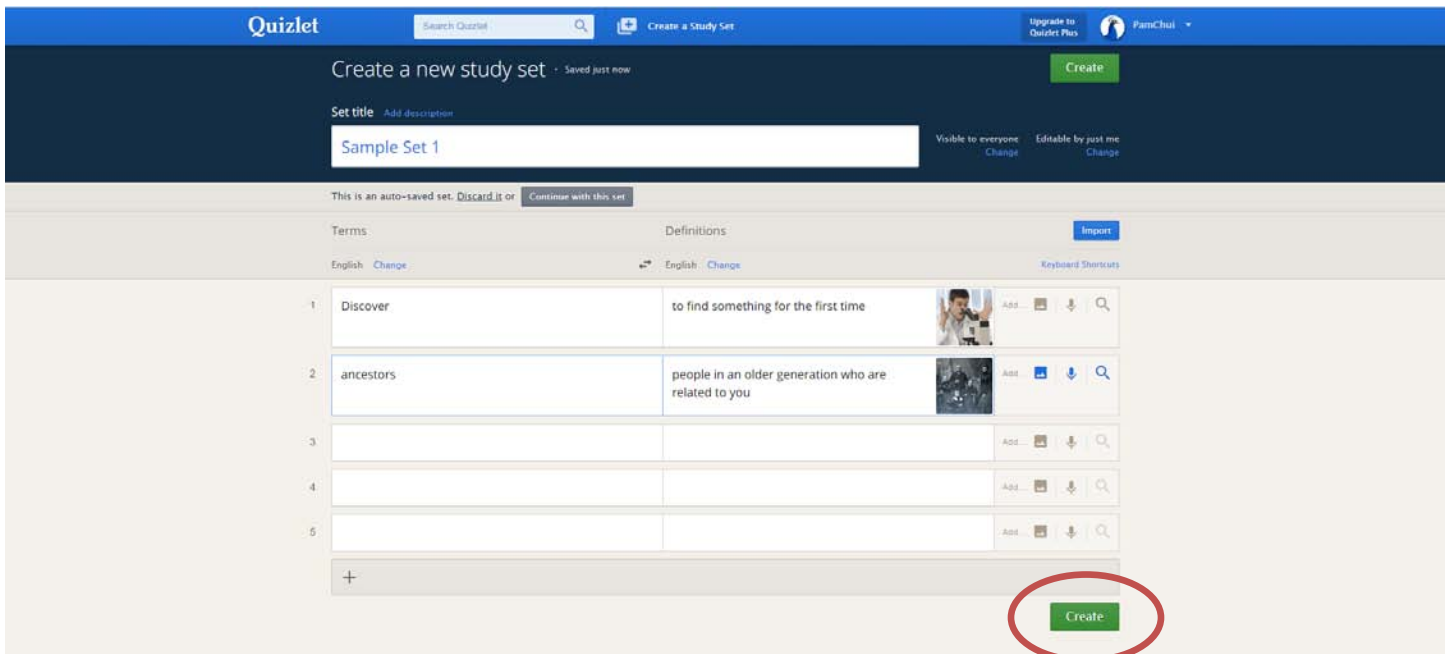
Put the vocabulary words on the left side and the meaning of the words on the right side.

You can add pictures to your words.

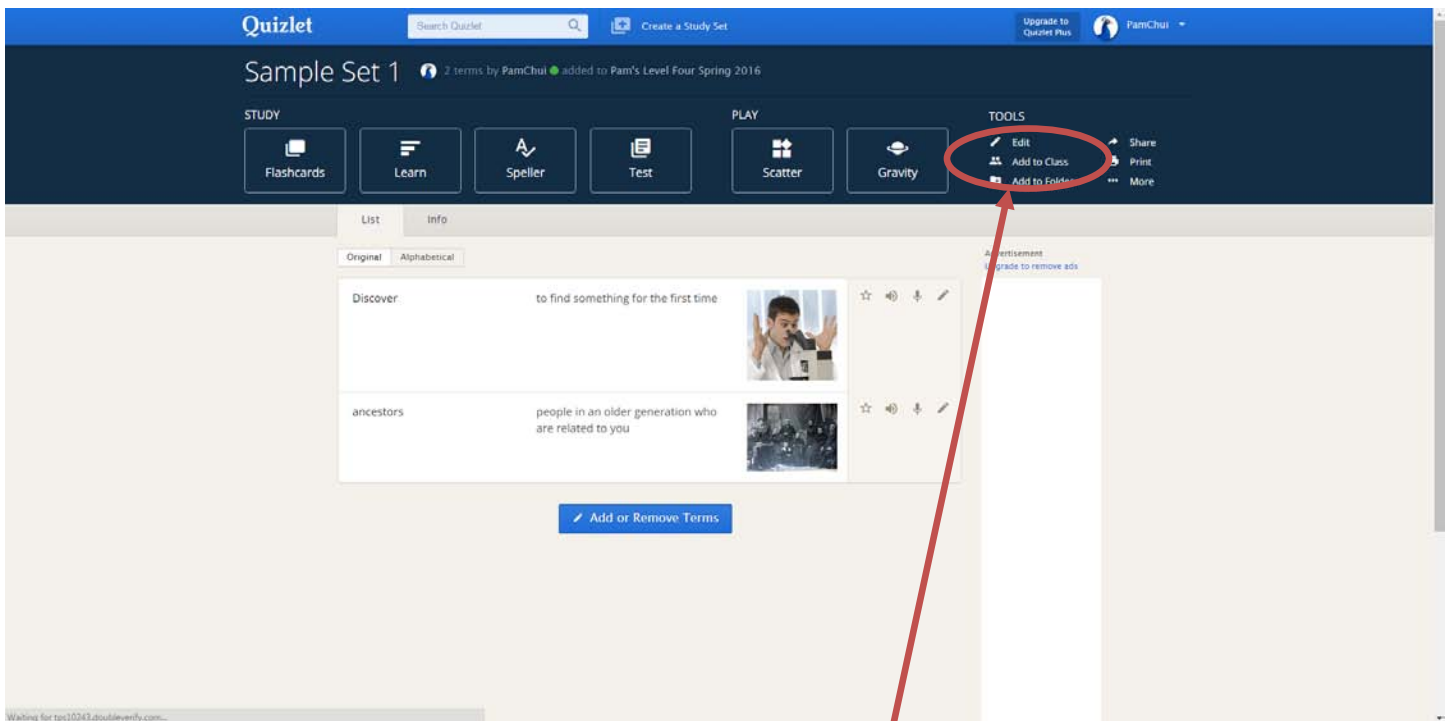


Click on the box on the right side of the word, and pictures will show up. Select the image you want.

After you select a picture, the picture will appear next to the word.



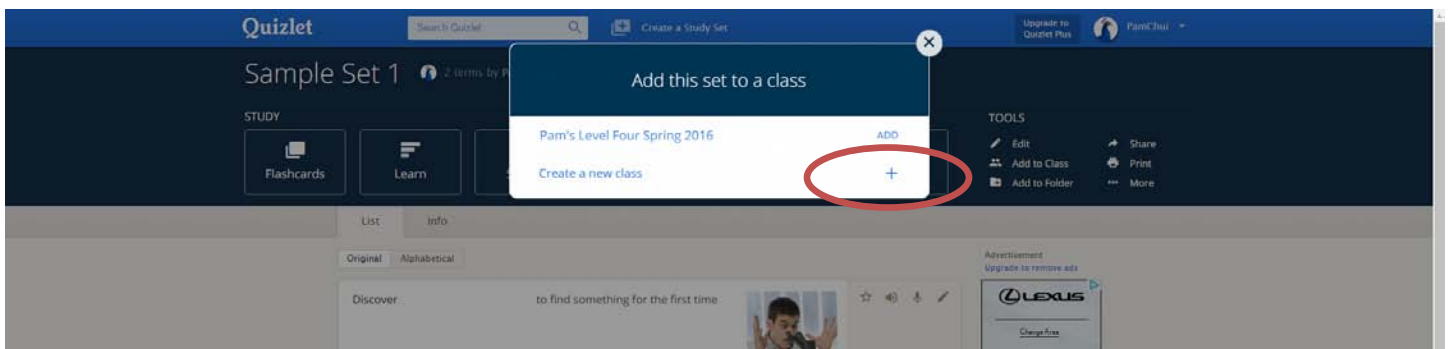
Click “Create” when you have finished typing in all your vocabulary words.



This is what it will look like when you're all done!

Add your set to the class by clicking “Add to Class”.

Then click “ADD”.



Note if it says “REMOVE” next to the class, the set was already added to the class.
If it says “REMOVE” and you click “REMOVE”, the set will be taken OUT of the class.
